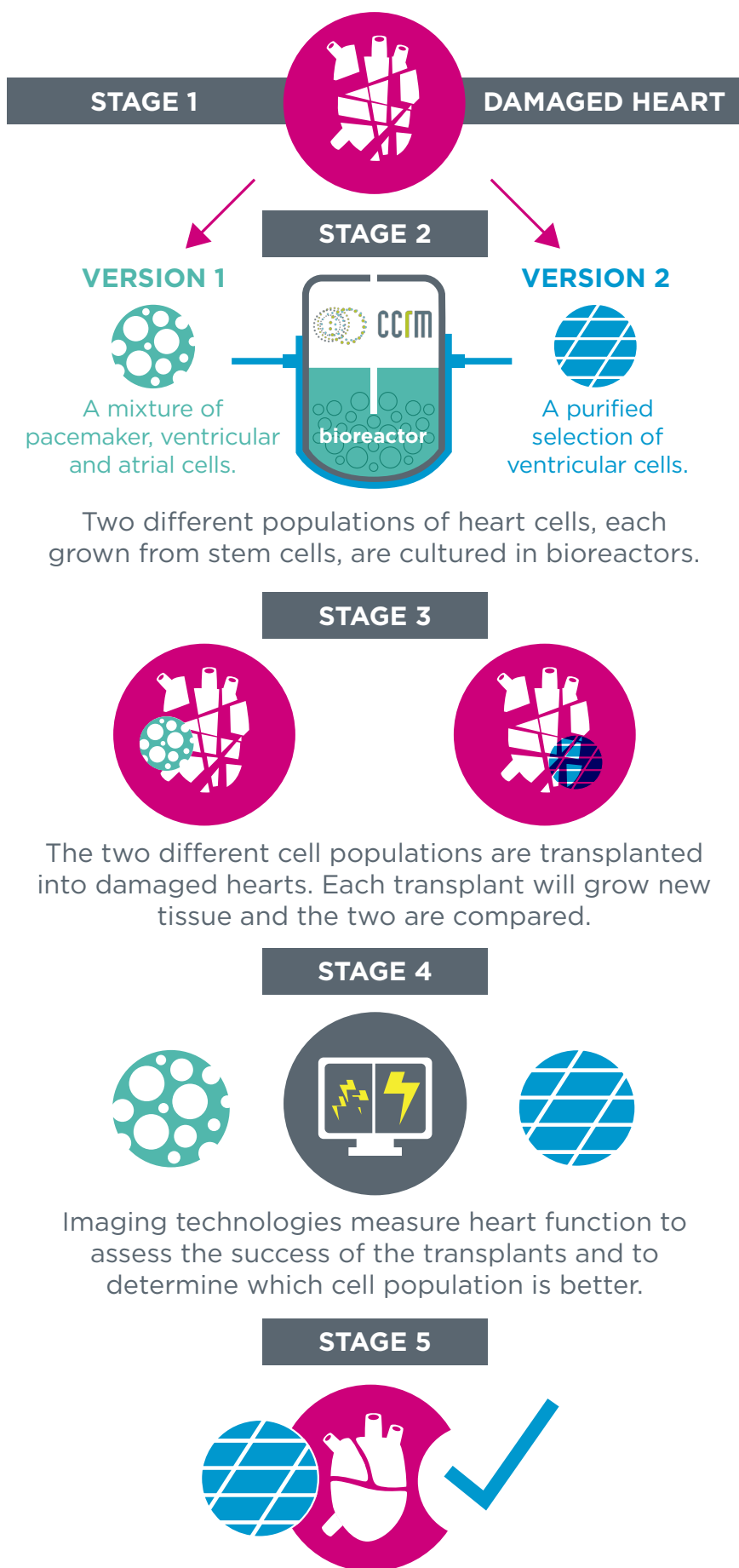


CHANGE IN HEART

After a heart attack, scar tissue can severely limit heart function and lead to heart failure and other associated illnesses. In Toronto, a team led by Dr. Michael Laflamme at the University Health Network is testing how cultivated stem cells, injected into the damaged heart, can form new, healthy tissue.
