Use single spaced, Calibri (minimum size 12) font, with 1-inch margins, and name the file using the Lead PI name (i.e. Joe Smith – SFIRM NOI.docx). Applicants with high potential projects will be invited to submit a **Full Application**. Instructions for Full Application will be sent to those invited. Full grant applications are due **Friday, May 31, 2019 by 4:00 pm EST** to jill.furnival@sfirm.ca.
